



➤ Go to https://www.tradeatlas.com/en and login with your username and password






2. Defining Your HS Codes

➤ Click on your account name and follow My Profile → My HS Codes




> Type or select your 6-digit HS codes and click SAVE button to add the number of codes your plan allows you to add




3. Making Searches on the System


➤ Click on SEARCH button at the top of the page and find SHIPMENT SEARCH. This will take you to the search area.




 On the Shipment Search screen, you can enter the date information as you wish or use one of the predefined options in the system:
 "This Year," "Last Year," or "Last 3 Years" to filter the results.




➤ Start typing your HS code or definition of your code (such as 080810 or Apple for the code: "080810 – Apples, Fresh"), click on the code from dropdown menu and click search




➤ You will see the results page for the HS code you searched. From 01.01.2018 till the latest data, our database has 19.000+ importers with 1.000.000+ shipments (as of 04.02.2025)



➤ On the Shipment Search screen, you will see the number of companies & shipments in our database by country and the number of shipments by month for the code you searched for.



➤ On the Shipment Search screen, you will see the total number of shipments for the code you searched for within the selected date range, as well as the shipment counts categorized by importer and exporter countries on the left side of the screen. You can select the country you want to view in this area and filter the shipments accordingly.




➤ As you scroll down, you will see the importers sorted by the number of shipments for the selected code (in this example, fresh apple shipments).



> You can click on the shipment count of any company to view its shipments in detail.







You can click on the Google icon to search for the company name on Google or click on the contact details if available.






➤ You can click on Download button to download details of the shipments. Please note that you can download 10.000 records at once, so if you want to download more, you can limit the search dates and download all the data periodically or select importing country/countries. System will ask your preferred number of lines to be downloaded, and automatically download the latest records when you download any number of transactions.




- ➤ When you open the excel file, you will see 2 tabs:
 - First tab has every detail an import/export declaration form includes depending on availability of data, such as dates, importer and exporter companies, HS codes, product definitions, and for some countries, even prices, quantities, notify parties, ports...



 Second tab is a summary of all importers in the Excel file you downloaded, ranked by the number of shipments, and contact information for those importers.




➤ If you want to search for an exporter company to analyze its customers, enter the company name in the "Exporter Firm" field in the Shipment Search area and click "Search" (For example, to find Microsoft's customers).



➤ If you want to search for an importer company to view its suppliers, enter the company name in the "Importer Firm" field in the Shipment Search area and click "Search" (For example, to find Microsoft's suppliers).



➤ If you want to search for product descriptions, enter the product name in the "Product Details" field in the Shipment Search area and click "Search" (For example, to find buyers and sellers of XBOX).




4.Google-Like Search Feature

- ➤ You can use Google-like search features (signs) in TradeAtlas when searching for Product / Company name / Brand name areas. This will help you to get clearer results by including what exactly you are looking for, and excluding what you never need.
- > Below are the signs, their meanings, and some examples:



- ➤ Here are some additional explanations about this feature:
 - ➤ All search keywords start searching the words from the beginning. When you search by entering only "pro" in the "Product Details" field;



you will get "PRODUCT" / "PROFESSIONAL" but you will not get "APRON" / "IMPROVE"

➤ When you enter multiple keywords in the "Product Details" field and press Enter to search,




You can retrieve search results containing the exact phrase "BLUE FISH," such as "BLUE FISH SPOON REST" or "FROZEN BLUE FISH," but you will not get results like "BLUEY FISHING TOY" or "BLUE WHITING FISH."

➤ When you enter multiple keywords in the "Product Details" field, first press Enter and then click the "OR" button to search;




You can retrieve search results that contain or do not contain the exact phrase "Green Apple," such as "GREENFRESH APPLES" or "FRESH GREEN QINGUAN APPLE."

➤ Here is a detailed example for an advanced search with signs:




The shipments appearing in this sample search must have been made with HS code 151219 within the last 3 years.



5.Filtering Company Names

- Due to the data collected from various countries, and as each country has it's own attitude to release the data, shippers, banks, customs agents, or even empty / meaningless names are sometimes seen as importer
- > Examples are;
 - TNT / Fedex / UPS / Commerzbank / HSBC / (blank) / . / #
- ➤ If you are looking for importers instead of analyzing shipments, there are 2 options on the search area where you can exclude
 - o Blank company names
 - o And logistics, customs brokers and finance companies




- ➤ When you click the first box "Include blank companies", results on the page and also excel file will include some shipments where importer name is not visible
- ➤ When you click the second box "Include logistics, customs brokers and finance companies", results will include shipments arriving to logistics companies etc. so final buyer is generally not clear.

➤ Here is a chart as an example, demonstrating the importer names you will see in each 4 options:

6. Multi-Variable Searches

➤ For all searches, date and importing country are mandatory variables while you have to choose whether to search by HS Code, Company name or Product details. However, you can also search with more than 1 variable. You can select dates and importing country for your search which are mandatory, and then add the variables you like to search.



- ➤ You can add variables as exemplified below. This search result will show you all XBOX shipments under 950450 HS code from Maintek, China to Microsoft, Angola during 2020:
- Mandatory variables

■ Dates : 01.01.2020 / 31.12.2020

Product Detail : XBOX

■ HS Code : 950450 – Video game consoles






- You can also use more than 1 variable in the following fields;
 - o HS Code
 - Importer Country
 - Exporter Country
- For ex, below is the screenshot for apple (080810), banana (080300) or orange (080510) imports of USA or Canada, from Chile, Mexico or Peru




➤ If you want to include the variables "Brand Name," "Arrival Port," and "Departure Port" in your search, you can expand your search by clicking the `icon.



> To clear all your search inputs at once, you can click the 2 icon.




> To pin or unpin the search bar, you can click the * icon.



7. Country Groups

- > For importing country and/or country of origin, you can select pre-defined country groups instead of a single country.
- As an example, this helps you to search shipments from/to the following areas:
- o Oil shipments from Middle East to South America
- o Textile shipments from Asia to Southern Europe
- o Machinery shipments from Germany to NAFTA Area
- o Medicine shipments from OECD countries to OPEC countries
- ➤ The graph below shows the country groups you can choose from. To view country groups in both the importer and exporter country sections, please check the "Group Countries Only" button.



8.Searching Exporters (Suppliers)

If you want to view a country's exports, switch your search to an exporter search, apply the following criteria, and click the Search button (Example: Germany's chocolate exports to the world).




9. Excluding Variables

- ➤ You can use the EXCLUDE feature when selecting countries (importer and/or exporter), product details, HS code, importer company, and exporter company.
- For example, if you do not want to access a specific export/import country, you can exclude that country. When you enter a country in either field and hover over it with your mouse, you will see the EXCLUDE button. Clicking it will turn the country's color red, indicating that it has been removed from the search results. Some examples for both importer and exporter countries are shown below.


You want to find chocolate exporters all over the world except Belgium exporters:




You want to find shoe importers in Africa except Egypt and Libya:



➤ You can also exclude an HS code from your search results. For example, if you want to search for "Mouse" shipments worldwide but do not want to see live animal shipments (generally used for laboratory purposes):



➤ You can also exclude product details from your searches. For example, if you want to search for "Apple" shipments worldwide but do not want to see shipments containing "Green" in the product details:



10. What to Care When Searching Elective Variables

HS CODE SEARCHES

As known, the first 6 digits of HS codes are common all over the world representing the same product, and millions of products are categorized under six thousand 6-digit HS codes. That's why some HS codes directly represent a commercial product clearly while others include a great number of different products. If you are searching a non-clear 6-digit code, care to add another variable to get more effective and accurate results. Examples of code types in terms of clearance;

Clear codes

■ 07 02 00 : Tomatoes

■ 15 09 10 : Olive oil, virgin

■ 85 16 31 : Hair dryers

➤ Non-clear codes

• 01 06 90 : Other live animals

• 55 12 99 : Other woven fabrics of synthetic fibers

■ 84 26 19 : Cranes

COMPANY NAME SEARCHES

- Company names are not internationally standardized all over the world, mainly due to additions at the end
 - Microsoft Inc / Microsoft Corporation / Microsoft Corp
- ➤ There are several different companies having common phrases
 - ➤ Apple Inc / Apple Film / Apple Fashion / Apple Fasteners
- ➤ Official company name is the data shown on the official customs forms, and some companies own a separate foreign trade company for international trading
- > Brand names are not visible as a company name on official forms
 - Milka is the brand name while official trader is Mondelez International

PRODUCT DETAIL SEARCHES

- ➤ Searching product details is not typical to searching a query on Google, this data is the definition area filled by exporters/importers on the customs declaration forms, so, please consider what an exporter would write to the definition on the official forms when exporting / importing
 - ➤ You generally don't write "fruit" when exporting Apples, you write "Apple", even you generally write more details defining the product traded such as "fresh apples" or "premium green apples, size 125/138"
- ➤ Some common words used in different industries could bring very unconnected results, so, use as unique definitions as possible in your industry to find best results;
 - ➤ If you search "mouse", you will get results of computer pointing devices, live animal trade, even some textile products such as "Mickey Mouse t-shirt" etc.
- ➤ Similar with company names, product definitions for a single product are also not standardized. For ex, if you export an iPhone, you can write "cell phone" or "smart phone" or even only "iPhone 15". All these searches will generate different results
- ➤ Since data is collected from 50+ countries customs where official languages are different, all the data is not in English. Irregular languages are listed below, so when searching company names and product definitions, please consider translation or local language spelling of your search criteria. If you search Apple (fruit);
 - Russia and CIS countries' data is in Russian (яблоко)
 - Ukraine data is in Ukrainian (яблуко)
 - Vietnam data is in Vietnamese (qua tao)
 - South American data is mainly in Spanish and some in Portuguese (manzana / maçã)
 - > Some African countries' data is in French (pomme)

SOME GENERAL NOTES

➤ The data we have, namely more than 3 billion lines of transactions collected from 50+ countries, is mainly in the following format:

- ➤ However, there are some countries who do not share HS codes, or definitions, even for some data, importer or exporter name is missing. So, use all alternatives searches to get every single result which would help you find what you are looking for.
- ➤ If you cannot find enough results for a specific product in a country, you can also consider searching
 - > Similar products (such as apple, pear, quince, etc.., which are believed to be traded by the same company at the same time)
 - Complementary products (such as cell phone camera and cell phone battery, which are both required to produce a cell phone)
 - ➤ Input and output analysis (such as search furniture exporters to sell wood glue, which is required to produce furniture)
